This illustrated talk is based on Sally's book 'The Plant Lover's Guide to Epimediums' and covers the more widely grown species and forms. It also introduces gardeners to the beautiful new species from China, and the hybrids that have been developed over the past 10 years, and are still being bred. <b>Plant sale.</b>
